Overview

For on-task students, there will be approximately 2 hours and 15 minutes of work per day. We will meet over Zoom at 9:00 each day for a 30 minute morning meeting. We will incorporate the online resources during in class instruction, so students should be familiar with nearly all online resources.

What resources will we need?

If we transition to distance learning, students will bring home the following:

- All materials from the blue column
- Laptop and charger
- Pencil box with school supplies
- 2 weeks of materials from the green column
- A "turn-in" folder for pick-up/drop-off
