Distance Learning Information

Overview

For on-task students, there will be approximately 3 hours of work per day. Morning meeting will be streamed over Zoom starting at 8:15 and lasting approximately 45 minutes. We will incorporate the online resources during in class instruction, so students should be familiar with nearly all online resources if they have previously been in class.

What resources will we need?

If we transition to distance learning, students will bring home the following:

- All materials from the blue column
- Laptop and charger
- Pencil box with school supplies
- 1 week of materials from the green column
- A "turn-in" folder for pick-up/drop-off

Materials from the yellow column can be accessed using the laptop and any additional materials from the green column will be picked up weekly from the school.
